Signs and Symptoms of a Fracture

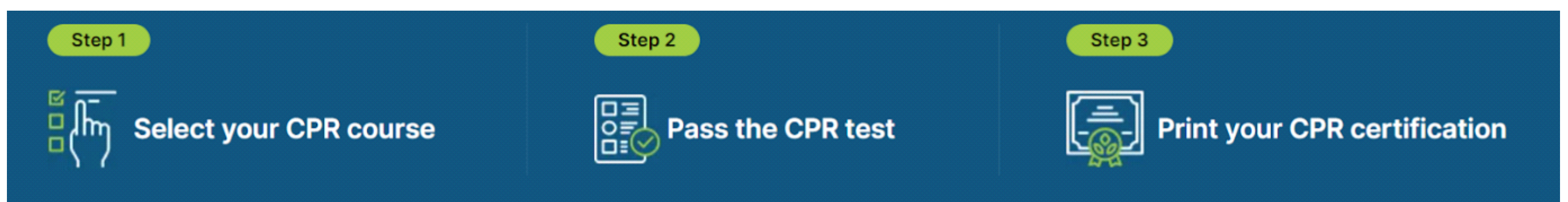
1. Swelling, bleeding, or bruising of the impacted area

3. Bone starts to protrude, and the skin breaks
4. Unable to move the body part which got hurt
5. Numbness and tingling
