Signs and Symptoms of a Fracture

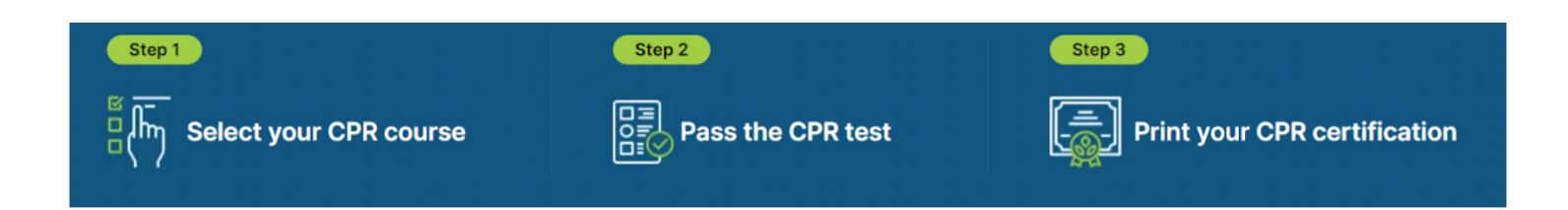
- 1. Swelling, bleeding, or bruising of the impacted area

- 4. Unable to move the body part which got hurt
- 5. Numbness and tingling
